Mohnton Borough Council met in regular session on the above date using an electronic forum ZOOM. The meeting information was advertised in the Reading Eagle and on the borough website to allow public participation.

Members participating were Dale Eisenhofer, Mary Gudikunst, Tim Moll, Dave Kurczewski, Mike Anderson, Brian Simmon and President Mike DeFeo who presided. Also present were Zachary Morey from Hoffert & Klonis and Mayor Gary Kraft.

#### ENGINEER

1. The 2020 Street Work project bids were opened and tabulated with New Enterprise being the low bidder with the amount of \$160,339.58. Dale Eisenhofer made a motion to award the project to New Enterprise, with Tim Moll seconding. A roll call vote was taken with all voting in favor.

#### PRESIDENT

1. A Resolution to extend the Flat Rate on Real Estate Taxes until September 30<sup>th</sup> was discussed. The Berks County Commissioners have already passed a resolution to change their portion of the tax billings. The County Tax Collection program will not allow for payments in different payment periods which is necessitating the borough adopting the resolution to change the borough and fire portion of the real estate tax bills to agree with the county. Dale Eisenhofer made a motion to approve Resolution #20200513, seconded by Tim Moll. A roll call vote was taken and all voted in favor.
2. There was discussion regarding ordinance and zoning enforcement during the State of Emergency. The council members agreed that enforcement should continue for all ordinances. Kraft Code Services will be notified.
3. The park is currently closed in keeping the order from Governor Wolf. When Berks County is moved to a Yellow Classification from the current Red, the passive portions of the park will reopen. Materials are on order and have been assembled to facilitate this partial reopening.

#### UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. A quote for a new aluminum utility body for the utility truck was received from E M Kutz in the amount of \$19,441 installed was received. Dale Eisenhofer made a motion to approve the purchase, seconded by Tim Moll with all voting in favor through a roll call vote.
