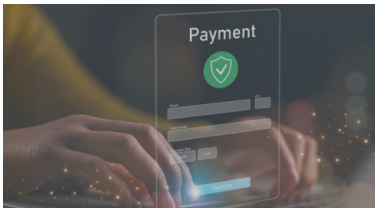

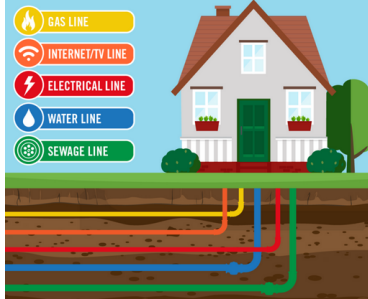

RENTAL REGISTRATION

Mohnton Borough requires landlords to register their rental properties with the Borough. The purpose of the rental registration program is to ensure that all rental properties meet basic health and safety standards.

Property owners are required to register their properties annually and pay the registration fee. Inspection fees are to be submitted every other year.

Blowing grass clippings into the street is illegal and creates dangerous conditions for motorcyclists and bicyclists by causing slick, unsafe surfaces. These clippings also clog storm drains, causing flooding and water pollution. Always direct mower discharge toward your lawn, not the road.

The Borough maintains the sewer system from the curb to the main. The trap into the house is the property owners responsibility. Sewer blockages from the house to the curb are the homeowner's responsibility. *It is very important not to flush anything other than toilet paper.*

Can I Flush This Down the Toilet?



Is it toilet paper?

Yes — toilet paper is safe to flush!

No — if it's not toilet paper, don't flush it! Avoid flushing:

- ✗ Paper towels
- ✗ Tissues
- ✗ Flushable wipes
- ✗ Menstrual products
- ✗ Hair
- ✗ Dental floss
- ✗ Medicine
- ✗ Cleansing pads
- ✗ Facial wipes
- ✗ Baby wipes
- ✗ Diapers
- ✗ Food waste



Running a stop sign — meaning not coming to a complete stop before proceeding — is **illegal, unsafe, and can lead to serious injury or death.**

Stop signs are designed to give drivers time to check for oncoming traffic, pedestrians, and cyclists before entering an intersection. Failing to stop can cause you to collide with a vehicle that has the right of way, another vehicle entering the intersection, or a pedestrian or cyclist. Even if the road seems empty, people can appear suddenly, especially at night or in low-visibility conditions.

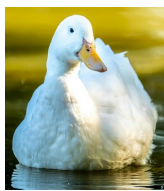

STORMWATER SMART LAWN CARE

When water from rain, snow, or sleet flows over the ground, it's called "stormwater." Stormwater can pick up debris, litter, fertilizer, and pesticides used for lawn care. And when that stormwater flows into street gutters, storm drains, and downstream, it can pollute rivers, lakes, and streams. Follow these simple pollution solutions to help keep local waterways clean and healthy!



DON'T MOW TOO LOW

Only remove 1/3 of the grass blade height and leave clippings on lawn to allow nutrients to return to the soil - they act as a natural fertilizer!



CAREFUL WITH CHEMICALS

Read the label when applying pesticides and fertilizers, use them sparingly, and avoid applying them to pavement. When there is rain in the forecast, any chemicals you apply can wash downstream.



ONLY RAIN IN THE DRAIN

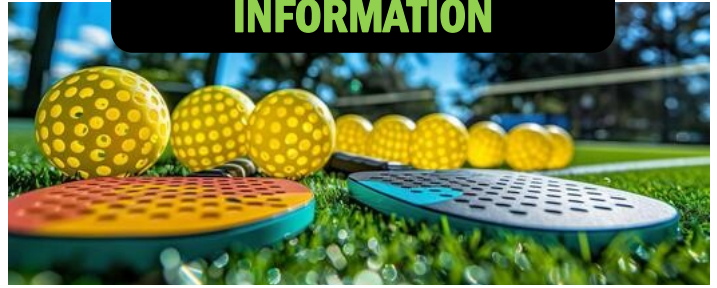
Don't rake, sweep, or hose debris down the storm drains. Leaves, yard clippings, and trash can clog storm pipes, causing floods and polluted waterways.



CURB YOUR WATER WASTE

Direct sprinklers toward the lawn and away from pavement to save water and keep chemicals and debris out of storm drains.

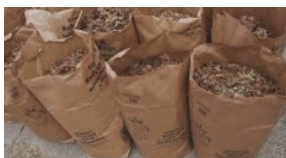

Mohnton Borough provides yard waste curbside collection by our Public works crew.

Beginning: April 6
Ending: November 9

Every Monday
(Tuesday following a holiday)

ALL YARD WASTE MUST BE CURBSIDE BY 7:30AM.

Items must be in paper bags or bundled, **no larger than 4 foot lengths**. Do not use tape to close your bags. Bags cannot weigh more than 50 lbs. **Overweight bags and non bundled items will be left at curbside.** If you believe your waste was missed at pickup, please be patient, our crew will get to you.

You may also deposit yard waste in the dumpster at 21 N. O'Neil Street parking lot. **Mohnton residents only.** Dumpster—Emptied on Thursdays.
